Three Different Funding Sources

1. Alonzo A. Crim Center for Urban Educational Excellence (02905)

This fund helps defray some of the cost of non-budgeted expenses associated with initiatives such as our DREAMS mentoring project, undergraduate service programs, and Annual Sources of Urban Educational Excellence Conference. This fund also supports endeavors such as interviewing candidates for positions; purchasing plaques for Honors Day, and providing gifts to retired teachers. Finally, this fund is used for alleviate some of the cost of conducting research by our doctoral and master students.

2. Alonzo and Gwendolyn Crim Scholarship (02D28)

Presently, the Crim Center has been able to provide 52 scholarships to urban teachers in pursuit of the Masters’ of Science degree in Urban Teacher Leadership offered by the Crim Center in collaboration with all three units in the EPS department.

3. The Alonzo A. Crim Teacher Leader Fellows (02D28)

Each year two Atlanta Public School Teachers will be awarded stipends of \$2,500 for leadership projects that further the work of Dr. Crim. The Crim Teacher Leader Fellows will be awarded stipends for one of the following:

- A. Facilitating summer institutes for Atlanta Public School students or teachers;
- B. Leading in-service or pre-service trainings for urban teachers;
- C. Engaging in research projects that explore best instructional practices for economically disenfranchised children of color;
- D. Designing and implementing new curriculum for classrooms of African Americans or other children of color;



E. Leading other projects (not listed above) that are congruent with the mission of the Center and the life's work of Dr. Alonzo A. Crim, to include only those that impact economically disenfranchised children of color.
