

**GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY
COLLEGE OF EDUCATION
SCHOLARSHIP**

The Student Affairs Committee of the College of Education has established the following guidelines for the distribution of available College of Education scholarship funds:

1. There will be two \$200 scholarships awarded twice each year for a total of four awards each year.
2. The scholarships will be awarded each time to one undergraduate and one graduate student.
3. The criteria for receiving the scholarships are:

Undergraduate (at the time of application)

Every applicant who meets the minimum GPA of 3.0 will be considered equally according to the following criteria:

- Student must be a rising junior or have completed the freshman and sophomore core.
- Student is presently enrolled in the College of Education.
- Student has completed 9 hours in the College of Education
- Student is in good standing in the College of Education.
- Student shows a pattern of department/program involvement (professional organizations, SGAE student representation on committees, etc.).
- Student shows financial need.
- Students must have a letter of recommendation from a professor in his/her department.

Graduate (at the time of application)

Every applicant who meets the minimum GPA of 3.5 will be considered equally according to the following criteria:

- Student is presently enrolled in the College of Education.
- Student has completed 9 hours in the College of Education.
- Student is in good standing in the College of Education
- Student shows a pattern of scholarship (e.g. the presentation of research at professional meetings, publications).
- Student shows financial need.
- Student must have a letter of recommendation from a professor in his/her department.

Deadlines: October 1

The Student Affairs Committee will decide which students will receive these awards. A student may apply for this scholarship more than once. The award will be deposited directly into the recipient's university account.
