

Asa G. Hilliard III Memorial Scholarship

Call for Nominations

The Asa G. Hilliard III Memorial Scholarship recognizes excellence at the post-baccalaureate level and bears a \$1,000 award. The selected graduate-level student's leadership, scholarship and activities in urban education settings will have improved – and will demonstrate the promise to continue to improve – the educational context and/or student development and learning in these settings. The recipient will be recognized at the College of Education & Human Development's Scholars Reception in Spring 2022.

Scholarship Criteria

Nominees must:

- Be a graduate level student in good academic standing in the College of Education & Human Development
- Have achieved a high level of academic achievement
- Actively exemplify the work and/or research of Dr. Asa Hilliard III
- Demonstrate activities and/or leadership leading to the improvement of urban education
- Utilize funds for tuition, fees, books, room, board or other relevant expenses incurred by a graduate student
- Agree to serve as liaison and volunteer at Asa G. Hilliard Elementary School on behalf of the college



Nomination Process

Nominees should submit:

- Nominee's letter addressing the eligibility criteria listed above and proposed use of funds
- Nomination letter from major professor addressing selection criteria
- Nominee's Panther ID number, e-mail address(es), phone number and mailing address

Materials submitted beyond the stated requirements will not be considered.

Deadline

The selection committee for this award is appointed by the dean. Completed nomination packets must be received no later than **Oct. 22, 2021**.
