Summary of Expedited/Low-Cost Program

For teachers who want to complete self-paced courses outside of GSU.

- Teachers take 6 single-credit courses and earn their badges in the Georgia Virtual platform.
 - As a bonus, teachers can submit final products from three of these courses for an ISTE endorsement in Computational Thinking.
- Teachers apply for the Computer Science Endorsement program at Georgia State by March 15.
- Teachers take 2 synchronous online courses (LT 7502 and 7503) June-July.
