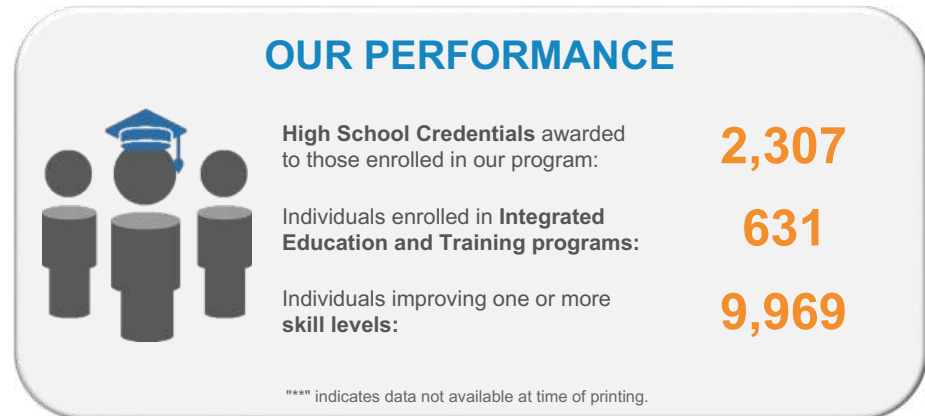
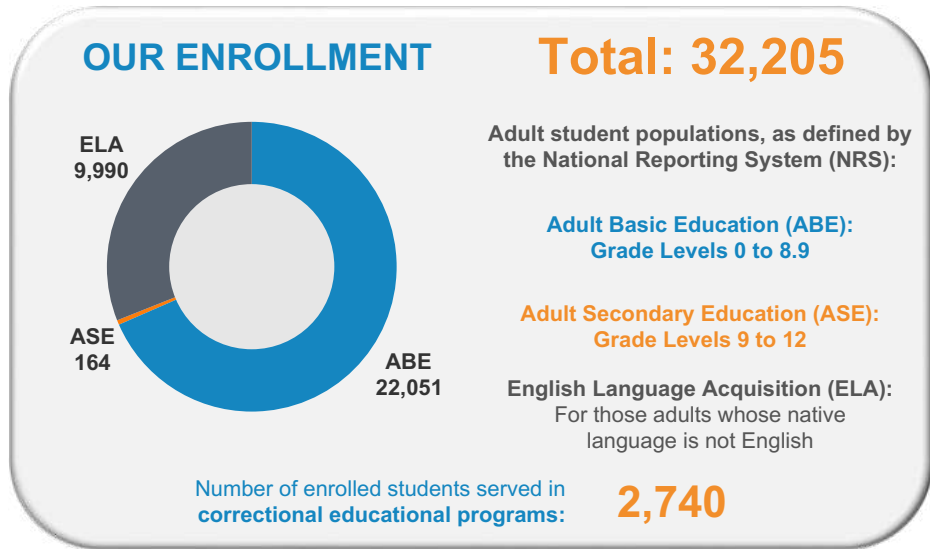
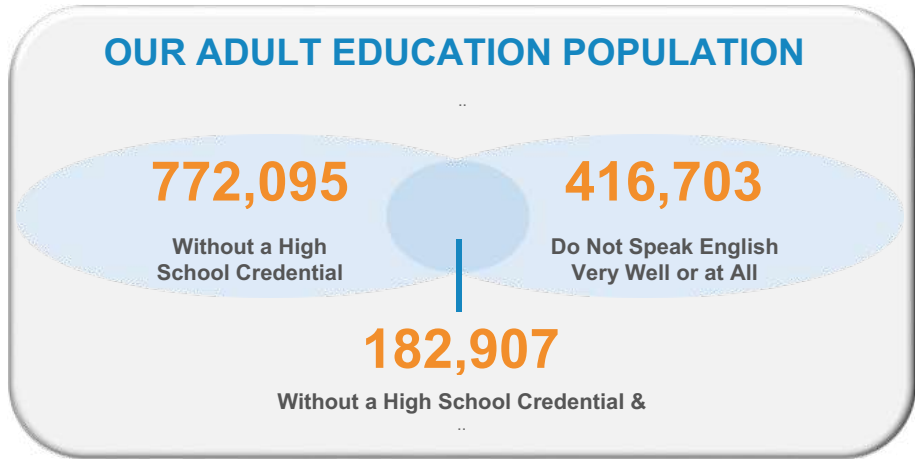

PURPOSE: Adult education programs in all 50 states, DC, and U.S. territories are authorized under Title II of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act to assist adults in building skills and earning credentials that lead to postsecondary education, sustainable employment, and economic self-sufficiency.
