Spring — **October 1**

b ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE B-5 MAJOR

- Areas A-F completed (you may apply to the B-5 program the semester before you complete all Area A-F requirements)
- Minimum GPA of 2.75
- Submit proof of tort liability insurance
- Passing score on the GACE Program Admission Assessment or SAT/ACT exemption*
- Complete the Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment - (360)
